Youth Program Admission Policies and Procedures

A. International Students

To apply from outside of the US, we will need the following information and fees:

- Completed High Expectations' Application Form.
- US \$250.00 for the Application/Registration fee.
- A bank statement for the last three months, original and translated to English, from your account or your sponsor/guardian's account, showing sufficient funds to pay all your personal expenses while studying in the US. For each month of classes, you must provide proof of US \$1,500 for your expenses.

After your completed application is received:

- Please maintain a valid email account during the entire application process.
- Once accepted, students will receive an email from admissions@highexpectationsusa.com with an I-20 Form and official acceptance packet. This I-20 Form is the immigration document that you will need to apply for a student visa at your local U.S. Embassy or Consulate.
- Submit SEVIS Fee: US \$350.00 for SEVP by debit or credit card.
- Before the start of class, attend orientation and pay the full amount of the tuition and book/material fees.

B. Transfer Students

To transfer to High Expectations from another SEVP-certified institution, we will need the following information and fees:

- Completed High Expectations' Application Form.
- US \$250.00 for the Application/Registration fee.

• A bank statement for the last three months, original and translated to English, from your account or your sponsor/guardian's account, showing sufficient funds to pay all your personal expenses while studying in the USA. For each month of classes, you must provide proof of US \$1500 for your expenses.

Transfer students must also:

- Provide your current institution with a Letter of Acceptance from High Expectations.
- Complete and submit the F-1 Student Transfer Information Form. High Expectations' DSO will then contact your current institution to initiate the transfer.
- Maintain status by attending classes at your current institution until the transfer release date is established by the DSO.
- Before the start of class, attend orientation and pay the full amount of the tuition and book/material fees.

C. Students Seeking Change of Status

To apply for a change of status from tourist (B1/B2) to student (F1) in the US, please provide the following

documents:

- Completed High Expectations Application Form
- US \$250.00 for the Application/Registration fee
- Copy of your passport
- Copy of your Visa
- Copy of your Form I-94
- A bank statement for the last three months, original and translated to English, from your account or your sponsor/guardian's account, showing sufficient funds to pay all your personal expenses while studying in the USA. For each month of classes, you must provide proof of US \$1,500 for your expenses. Note: If your sponsor is in the US, you must submit a Form I-134 completed by your sponsor.
- Change of Status Request Letter (in English).
- Change of Status Applications are processed by a third-party.
